Lifetime Teaching License Changes

Effective: August 1, 2017, under Act 588 of 2017, the Lifetime Teaching License is also available to persons who are retired under one of the retirement provisions shown below, whether or not they are 62 years of age.

Although the rules are in the process of being amended, the Department of Education will issue the license under Act 588 on and after August 1.

See the attachment for the new eligibility requirements and instructions for applying. There is NO FEE for a Lifetime Teaching License.

Lifetime Teaching License (as amended by Act 588 of 2017)

Effective: August 1, 2017, the Lifetime Teaching License is also available to persons who are retired*, whether or not they are 62 years of age.

Please Note:

- Until the online application is changed, <u>persons who are retired but under age 62 will have to complete a paper application</u>.
- There is NO FEE for a Lifetime Teaching License

The new requirements are as follows:

- 1. Hold a current or expired Arkansas teaching license;
- 2. Be 62 years of age or older OR have retired* from active teaching under one of the following:
 - Ark. Code § 24-7-701 (voluntary retirement at age 60 with 5 yrs of service or at any age with 28 yrs of service);
 - Ark. Code § 24-7-702 (early voluntary retirement at any age with combined total of 25 yrs or more); or
 - Ark. Code § 24-7-704 (disability retirement)
 - *ALL QUESTIONS RELATING TO TEACHER RETIREMENT SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE ARKANSAS TEACHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM, 501-682-1517, 1-800-666-2877, info@ATRS.gov
- 3. Meet one of the following:
 - Worked in an educational setting while licensed
 - Made significant contributions to education, educational research, or the profession of teaching through scholarly endeavors, teaching experience, excellence in teaching, or educational innovation

4. Successfully complete the background checks required for licensure, if not already completed within the last 12 months (for more information on background checks go to: http://bit.ly/2dsP5d5

Professional Development Requirements:

- A lifetime teaching license holder is not required to complete the 36 hours of annual PD for licensing purposes.
- However, a lifetime teaching license holder employed by a school district must complete all PD
 required by the school district (including professional growth plan requirements under TESS).
 Therefore all PD requirements should be discussed with the school district where the license holder is employed.
